

LGV/HGV DRIVER MENTOR - COURSE CONTENT AND OVERVIEW

An LGV/HGV Driver Mentor plays a crucial role in guiding and supporting new employees, particularly those with limited industry experience, helping them grow and develop as driving professionals.

The LGV/HGV Driver Mentor course provides candidates with the necessary skills and knowledge to mentor and support drivers effectively. By fostering a strong mentoring culture, this course helps improve safety, attract and retain talent, and ensures new drivers receive the support they need during this important transition.

Based on the <u>European Mentoring and Coaching Council's (EMCC)</u> competence framework, the course covers key areas such as managing diversity, maintaining professional boundaries, helping mentees develop skills, and ensuring legal compliance. Mentors also learn essential techniques like active listening, effective questioning, checking for understanding, and delivering quality feedback.

All candidates must successfully complete an independent examination to qualify as an LGV Mentor – attaining an internationally recognised standard. Successful candidates are eligible to register on the RTITB Professional Register L.

- Have held a valid category C or C+E entitlement for 3 years or more
- Have significant experience as professional LGV drivers
- Have the confidence to deliver one-on-one or small group support to their peers Have good communication skills.
